

# NON-OBSERVED EVENTS USING TECHNOLOGY

## Utilize EQMS/FTE Application to enter event types below

Test No.	Type of Test	Purpose of Test	Means & Procedures For Conducting The Test
<b>301</b>	Event Recorder Analysis	Determine that train crews are complying with train handling rules, air brake test, GCOR through event recorder evaluation.	<p>Monitor event recorder for rule compliance.</p> <p>Event recorder may be used to monitor air brake requirements but will not fulfill the “Hands on Training.”</p> <p>Time the event is discovered when examining event recorder is the time that will be used on the COMMIT debriefing form.</p> <p>Monitor Oil Train / High Hazard Flammable Train HTUA Rule Compliance and Train Handling</p> <p>Note:  <i>When test is used for FRA 49 CFR part 232.203 refresher training “hands on”, a field debriefing MUST occur and all crew members questioned on proper knowledge and application of rules. Failure to properly answer will result in crew not qualifying for passing score for “refresher hands on training.”</i></p>
<b>302</b>	Video - Drive Cam	Determine that employees are operating vehicles according to rules and safe driving practices.	Review footage on recording from system activating event. Event must be entered into EQMS as “Non-observed coaching.”
<b>303</b>	Video - Recorded Video from cameras authorized for business purposes.	Determine that employees are operating trains according to operating rules.	Review footage on recording and evaluate compliance with operating rules. Event must be entered into EQMS as “non-observed coaching.”

### Additional Information

- Evaluations regarding developed technologies, for example Energy Management Systems, will be entered as Non-observed coaching event in COMMIT
- Video recordings, authorized for business purposes (Drive Cam, locomotive camera, etc.) that are not directly observed or reviewed at the time of an event will be entered as non-observed using appropriate Test No.
